Introduction

The Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board (“PGCB”) is pleased to present the fourth annual diversity report. This report provides an update regarding the PGCB’s efforts to monitor the activities of its slot machine licensees (“Licensees”) to ensure the Commonwealth’s goals of enhanced representation of diverse groups in the gaming industry and the creation of quality living wage jobs for residents of this Commonwealth.

Licensees established Diversity Committees, consisting of executive level staff, with the goal of promoting diversity in all aspects of their operations. The members of these Committees network with local colleges and universities, workforce development and job training organizations, local chambers of commerce, media outlets and entities such as Pennsylvania Career Link to support the success of their diversity goals. The activities of the Licensees are tracked and monitored by the PGCB to ensure participation of diverse groups in employment, training, development and retention.

Diversity training is conducted at all of the licensed facilities in order to foster an environment of inclusion for employees and to stress the importance of respect in the workplace. Management Apprentice programs are available for all employees aspiring to management level positions. These programs focus on the development of employees at all levels at the various facilities.

The statistical data provided in this report in the area of gaming service providers is impressive. However, we must continue to be mindful of the fact that a substantial portion of the funds expended by the Licensees during the last five years involved start-up costs, outlays associated with transitions from temporary to permanent facilities, costs associated with the purchasing of slot machines, table games and most related equipment. Since inclusiveness is a key component of diversity, the point must be stressed that there are no minority or women owned enterprises that manufacture slot machines.

In the past, the importance and fundamental value of local business enterprises in the communities in which the Licensees are located have received little to no recognition. This report includes figures pertaining to the Licensees total dollar expenditures to local businesses. The level of commitment to equality demonstrated by the Licensees in the area of procurement over the past five years serves as a testament of their hard work and “good faith” efforts.

Social responsibility in the form of community outreach, sponsorships and donations to local charities continue to be a priority for the Licensees. Employees at the facilities have volunteered thousands of hours to various organizations, fund raisers, neighborhood re-vitalization efforts and educational opportunities throughout the Commonwealth. Licensees have distributed approximately 21.5 million dollars towards philanthropic activities since 2006. Diversity in giving appears to be a mainstay in our gaming industry.

Finally, statistics pertaining to positions offered/hired, the number of table-games employees and the percentage of table-games employees who are residents of Pennsylvania has been added to this report.

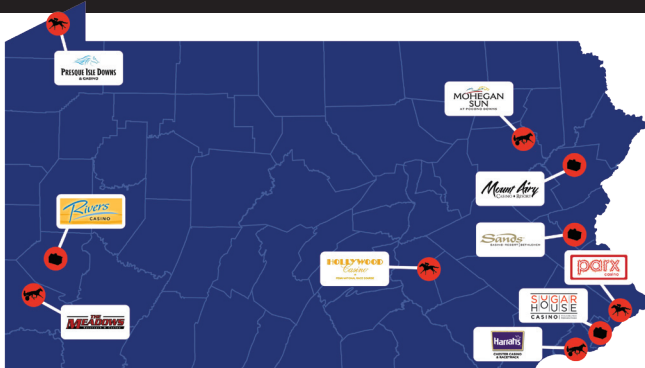

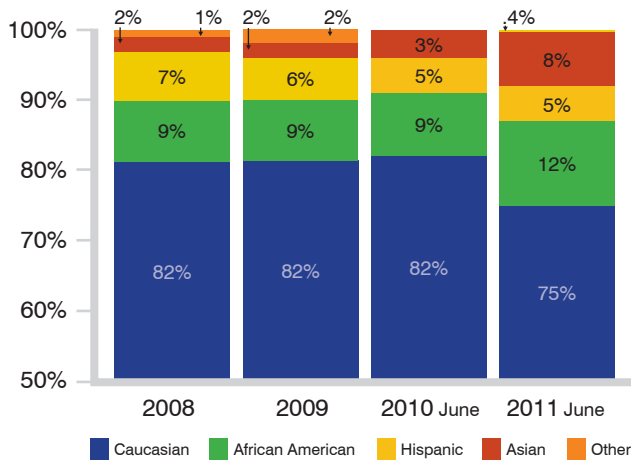

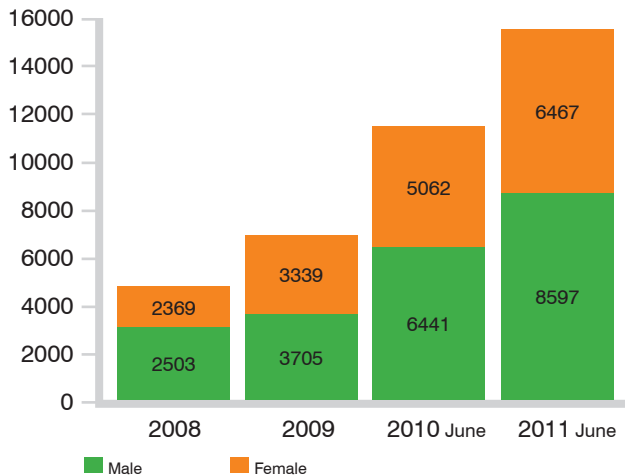


In addition to requirements in both the Gaming Act and the Board's regulatory policies and procedures, the PGCB requires each Licensee to execute a "Statement of Conditions" in which the Licensee agrees to submit an updated version of its diversity plan on an annual basis. As of June 30, 2011 PA casinos employed 15,064 individuals of which 13,062 (87%) are Pennsylvania residents. Additionally, Executive/Management/Professional staff consists of 2,083 individuals (Male 65%, Female 35%, Minorities 19%).

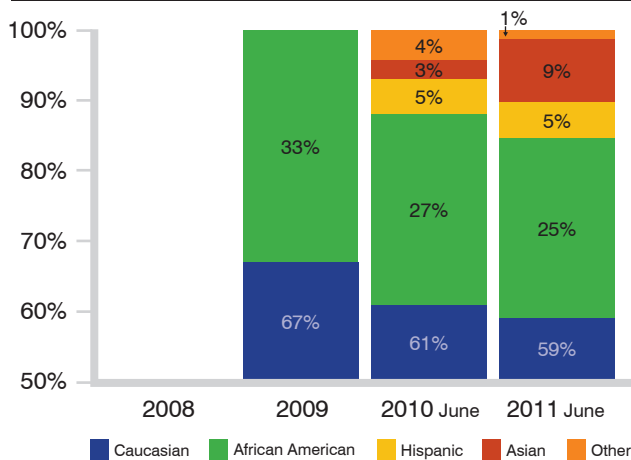

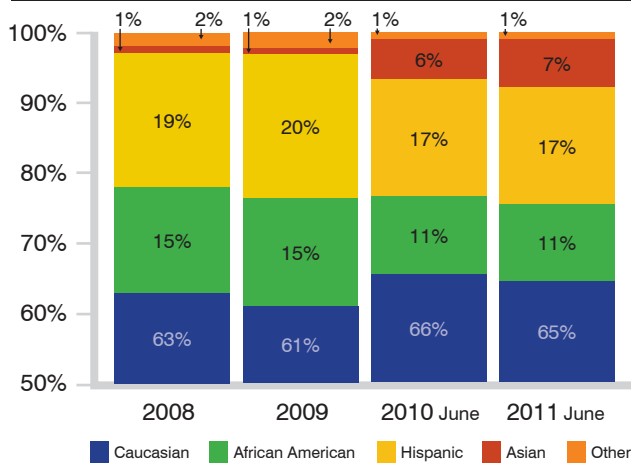

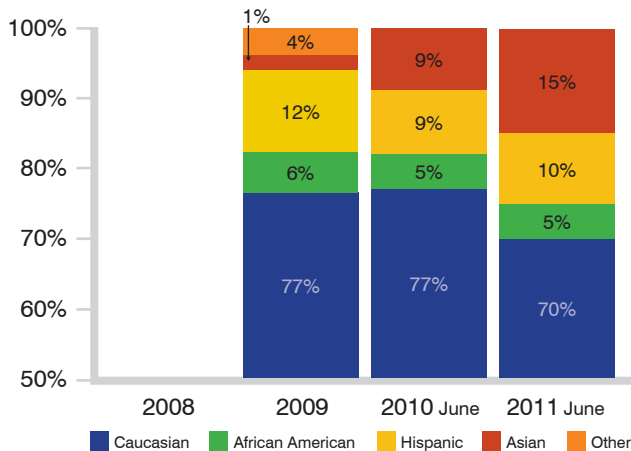

Sands Bethlehem has demonstrated a good faith effort to work closely with the Diversity Officer and the Commonwealth's Bureau of Minority and Women's Business Opportunities to increase minority participation in construction. However, the construction of the casino project is subject to a Project Labor Agreement that requires union affiliation of all of the labor and trades that perform work on the site. A number of the MBE/WBE vendors in the Lehigh Valley have no union affiliation, did not have the requisite staffing or skills to perform the work, and many trades that are minority certified and that are based outside of the greater Lehigh Valley have declined to travel to Bethlehem to work on the project due to travel related expenses.

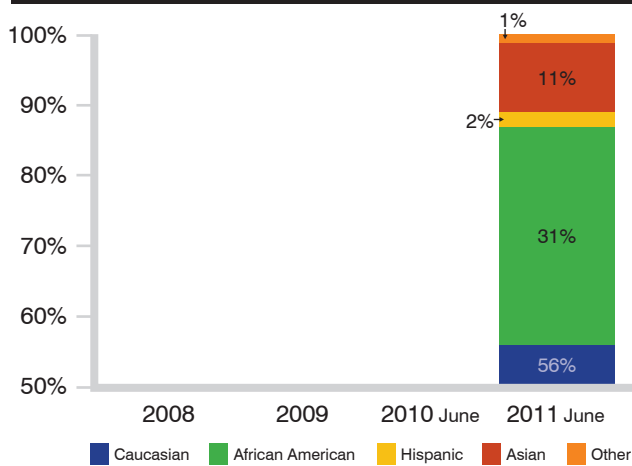

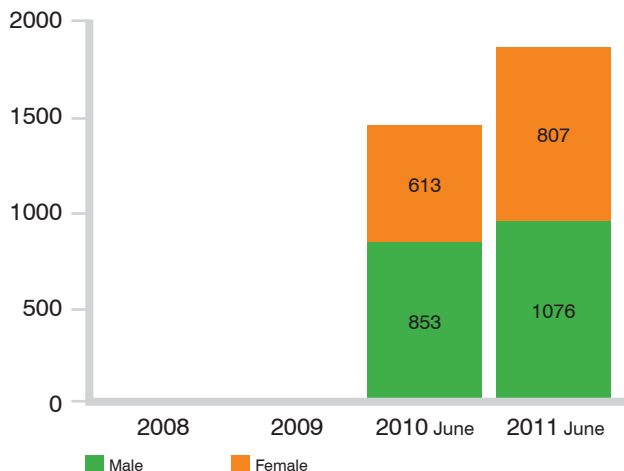
