A quorum of the Board being present, Chair Smyler called the meeting to order.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Chair Smyler announced that Commissioner Sean Logan resigned from the Board, effective July 5, 2022, to fill a vacancy on the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission. Chair Smyler stated that the Board will continue to conduct its business under the common law “Rule of Necessity” which stands for the principal that a government tribunal cannot simply stop conducting business because of the absence of a full board due to conflicts or resignations. For the record, with the absence of a legislative appointee to the Board and pursuant to Section 1201(f)(3) of the Pennsylvania Race Horse Development and Gaming Act, all votes

requiring a qualified majority of the Board will now be accomplished by a vote of the remaining 3 legislative appointees, and at least 2 of the 3 gubernatorial appointees to the Board.

Chair Smyler announced that the Board held an Executive Session on July 19th to discuss personnel matters, ongoing litigation and to conduct quasi-judicial deliberations relating to matters coming before the Board on July 20th.

Chair Smyler also announced that the Board has scheduled a Public Input Hearing relative to the license renewal application of the Mount Airy Casino and Resort. The hearing will be held on Wednesday, August 3, 2022, beginning at 10:30 a.m., at the Paradise Township Municipal Building, located at the intersection of Routes 191 and 940 in Cresco, Pennsylvania. The public is invited to attend and provide testimony on the renewal of Mount Airy's license.

Additionally, there is a mechanism by which interested persons can submit written comments into the public record. The details on how someone can register to speak or submit written comments can be found on the Board's website. I would note that the deadline to register or submit written comment is noon on Monday, August 1, 2022.

Finally, Chair Smyler announced that the Board's Office of Hearings and Appeals has issued a scheduling order relative to the pending casino license application filed by SC Gaming OpCo, LLC. SC Gaming OpCo, LLC, hopes to be issued a license to open a casino located in College Township, Centre County. Specifically, the order has established August 26, 2022 as the deadline for any party seeking to intervene in the licensing matter to file the requisite petition with the Office of Hearings and Appeals. The Order further establishes deadlines for responses to any petitions to intervene and a briefing schedule. The Scheduling Order is available on the Board's website or can be obtained by contacting the Office of Hearings and Appeals.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Kevin O'Toole stated that the Board's Office of Communications issued its press release yesterday to report casino revenue figures for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2022. Of particular note is the fact that overall gaming revenue in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania exceeded 5 billion dollars. This is the first time the Board has reached that plateau and, without a doubt, the gambling expansion initiatives played a big role in that accomplishment. Thirty-two percent of the total gaming revenue came from the gambling expansion initiatives that were launched in mid-2018. Sixty-eight percent of the gaming revenue came from the slot machines and table games that operate at Pennsylvania's land-based casinos.

With respect to the gambling expansion initiatives, of particular note is the growth of interactive gaming which provides players the opportunity to play online slot games and online table games from anywhere within the boundaries of Pennsylvania. Revenue from interactive gaming reached 1.23 billion dollars during only its third full fiscal year of operations.

The other forms of expanded gambling also performed quite well during this past fiscal year. Sports wagering generated 316 million dollars, Video Gaming Terminals at eligible truck stops generated 41.5 million dollars and fantasy sports contests generated 27.3 million dollars in revenue.

Land-based casinos also reached some milestones. Slot machine revenue totaled 2.41 billion dollars this past fiscal year, the highest total in the past 9 years. Pennsylvania's slot machine licensees do a great job in keeping their slot floors updated with the latest technology and innovations in slot machines so it is no surprise that slot revenue has grown during the past year.

Of particular note with respect to the land-based casinos, is the fact that table game revenue exceeded 1 billion dollars during a single fiscal year for the first time since table games were launched in July 2010. In total, table games generated 1.05 billion dollars for Fiscal Year 2021-2022. The land-based casinos continue to offer many of the available side wagers authorized by the Board that players enjoy playing can be found at most, if not all, table games. These side wagers serve to compliment the traditional rules of the game that maintain for players a fair opportunity to be successful when playing the table games.

The success this fiscal year at generating gaming revenue has resulted in gaming taxes to the Commonwealth of 2.05 billion dollars.

Before he concluded, Mr. O'Toole expressed his appreciation to all employees of the Gaming Control Board for their contribution to our important role of regulatory oversight.

OFFICE OF FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT

David Rhen provided a final report of Fiscal Year 2021-2022 expenditures. The fiscal year concluded June 30th. While the year has ended, the Board continues to receive invoices so expenditures will continue to accumulate over the next several months.

For the year, expenditures total 43.1 million dollars to date against an appropriation of 46.7 million dollars. It is anticipated that the Board will receive another 500,000 dollars in invoices bringing our total expenses to around 43.6 million dollars. To date, expenditures are up 3.6 million dollars or 9.2% from the prior year. Ninety percent of expenditures or 38.6 million dollars were for salaries and benefits with the remaining 10% or 4.5 million dollars for operating and fixed asset expenses.

Personnel expenses consisted of 23.2 million dollars for salaries, 15.1 million dollars for benefits, and 297,000 dollars for retirement leave payouts. Benefits as a percentage of salaries were 63%. Personnel expenditures increased 3.2 million dollars or 9% from the prior year. This increase is due to several factors, including new hires for casino openings and gaming expansion and the fact that prior year expenses were suppressed due to COVID closures that forced many employees into LWOP status. For the year, personnel expenses were nearly 3 million dollars less than planned due to a difference in the forecasted rate provided to the Board and implemented rates for retirement and health benefit contributions and to carrying 13 fewer employees on complement than budgeted.

In the operating category of expenses nearly 90% of expenses totaling 4.5 million dollars consisted of three subcategories: Rentals and Leases at 1.8 million dollars; services at 1.2 million dollars (this is primarily billings for administrative services provided by other Commonwealth agencies); and other operating expenses at 671,000 dollars, which includes fingerprinting services and database subscriptions for background investigations. Operating expenses increased by 673,000 dollars or nearly 18% from last year's total, however they were still 600,000 dollars less than prior to COVID. A good share of this increase is due to the replacement of employee computers which occurs every 4 to 5 years and other IT

storage and security upgrades.
